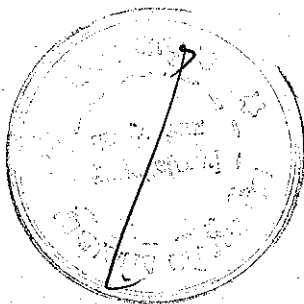

(08/01/2015)

Petitioner has preferred this writ petition seeking inclusion of his name in the voters list of Gram Panchayat, Rambhatha, District Janjgir-Champa.

2. Admittedly, the last date of filing nomination for the ongoing Panchayat Election is already over.
3. Under Rule 15 of the Chhattisgarh Panchayat Nirvachan Niyam, 1995 there cannot be any addition or deletion of name of any voter in the voters list which has already been finalized under the Rules.
4. Since, law is well settled that writ Court should not issue any direction or mandamus contrary to the express statutory provision, the prayer made in the writ petition cannot be allowed at this stage.
5. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
