3. In view of the fair submission made by the State counsel, the present petition is disposed of permitting the petitioner to file a detailed

representation before the Collector along with copy of this petition. In eventuality of doing so, it is expected from the Collector and other competent authorities to act strictly in accordance with law.

4. It is made clear that this Court has made no order on merit of the petition. The competent authority shall be at liberty to act in accordance with law.
5. The security amount deposited by the petitioner be refunded to him.
