The accused/applicant has moved this bail application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for releasing him on regular bail during trial in connection with Crime No.78/2015, registered at Police Station Utai, Distt. Durg, for the offence punishable under Section 20 (a) (i) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.
