Hon'ble Shri Justice Sanjay K. Agrawal**Order on Board****08/10/2015**

1. This is the first bail application filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail to the applicants, who have been arrested in connection with Crime No. 188/2015, registered at Police Station Dabhra, District Janjgir-Champa (C.G.), for the offence punishable under Sections 457, 380, 34 of Indian Penal Code.
2. After hearing learned counsel appearing for the parties and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case; nature and gravity of offence; the manner in which applicants are said to have stolen Rs. 60,000/- from the house of Complainant-Gopichand on 21/07/2015 and subsequent recovery from the applicants, this Court is not inclined to release the applicants on regular bail.
3. Accordingly, bail application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. is

rejected.
