ORDER :

1. The application is filed for relief of anticipatory bail. Both the sides are heard. This Court has perused the papers of investigation and the record of treatment given to the complainant Smt. Yogita. Present applicant is mother in law of Yogita.

2. In respect of the incident dated 21.9.2014 report was given on 25.9.2014. She has made allegations that her husband administered poison to her and present applicant had helped the husband. The record shows that history of consumption of poison was given. It is the husband, who had admitted the

complainant in hospital on 21.9.2014. Then she was shifted to other hospital also. Recovery of poisonous substance is made on the basis of statement given under section 27 of Evidence Act at the instance of husband and this Court has perused that statement. In view of the circumstance and as the applicant is lady this Court holds that protection needs to be given to the applicant.

3. Application is allowed. Interim protection granted to the applicant earlier is confirmed.
