Mr.Ghatol Patil learned counsel for respondent no.4 and

learned AGP for respondent nos.1 to 3 submit that the petitioner has an alternate remedy u/s 43 of the Maharashtra Agriculture Produce Marketing (Regulation) Act, 1963 against their order and the proceedings rejecting the application for resignation.

2] In light of the said submission, Mr.Patil, learned counsel for petitioner sought to canvas submissions on merits. We are not inclined to consider the same.
