2] Admit. By consent of the parties, taken up
for final disposal.

3] It is an admitted fact that the amount of
Rs.25,000/- awarded under Section 140 of the Motor

Vehicles Act, against which present appeal is preferred, was deposited by the appellant and the same is already withdrawn by the original claimant.

4] In that view of the matter, at the request of both the sides, present appeal is disposed of without any order on merit, with no order as to costs.
