PER COURT :

1. After having heard this matter for some time, learned Advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has preferred an independent suit bearing R.C.S. No. 87 of 2014 which is also pending before the Trial Court at Ahmednagar. The respondents herein have been impleaded as respondents in the said matter.

2. He, therefore, prays for liberty to withdraw this petition so as prosecute R.C.S. No. 87 of 2014 and move an appropriate

application before the competent authority for clubbing R.C.S. No. 87 of 2014 with R.C.S. No. 174 of 2011.
