1. Heard. Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners desire to avail of alternative remedy by filing appeal before the Appellate Authority against order dated 30.10.2014. In view of this, learned Counsel seeks liberty to withdraw the petitions. Liberty as prayed for is granted in the interest of justice. Learned Counsel submits that the petitioners would prefer appeal within four weeks from today. In view of this, interim relief granted vide
