Now the grievance is about unpaid salary and the subsistence allowance. The proposal is already submitted to the Education Officer (Secondary) [page 26].

2. Considering the above, we pass the following order.

3. The Education Officer (Secondary) shall take decision on the said proposal (page 26) expeditiously and preferably within a period of three (3) months from today. In case apart from said

proposal if the petitioner has any other claim of salary or otherwise the petitioner may make such representation to the authorities, which would be considered by the authorities on its own merits. The writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
