1) Heard. The petitioner is objecting to delimitation of the Wards declared by the Election authorities. The objection raised by the petitioner for delimitation appears to have been turned down by Collector, Ahmednagar on 9.2.2015.

2) Learned Counsel appearing for State Election Commission, on instructions, informs that the process of election has already set in motion and the acceptance of the nomination papers has commenced from 13th July, 2015.
