1. Leave to correct the title of respondent no.2.

This petition can be disposed of by issuing direction to respondent no.2 to take a decision on the caste validation claim furnished to the Committee in the year 2011 pertaining to the petitioner as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six months from today and it is accordingly directed.
3. The petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the Committee for expeditious disposal of his caste validation claim. The petitioner shall appear before the respondent Committee on 2nd November, 2015, and as such, no separate notice requiring his presence before the respondent Committee is necessary.
