2] Mr.Deshmukh, learned counsel for the applicant, submits that the applicant does not wish to press prayer clause (B), however, considering the difficulties of the present applicant/appellant, prayer clause (C) i.e. fixing the appeal for final hearing may be granted. He

submits that as the paper book is already supplied in the connected appeal, supply of paper book in the present appeal may be dispensed with.

3] In the circumstances, for the reasons stated in the application, the application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (C) and disposed of accordingly.
