Heard learned Counsel for respective parties.

It is informed that the appellant-Insurance Company has deposited an amount of Rs.28,28,210/- in this Court. The Tribunal has directed deposit of amount to the extent of Rs.Eight lacs in Fixed Deposit in any Nationalised Bank.

Considering the contentions raised before us, we are of the opinion that if the applicants are permitted to withdraw sum of Rs.15,00,000/- (Rs.Fifteen lacs), it would meet the ends of justice.

The applicants are permitted to withdraw an amount of Rs.15,00,000/- (Rs.Fifteen lacs) on condition of furnishing an

undertaking to this Court that in the event of success of appeal, applicants shall redeposit the amount in this Court within a period of eight weeks from such decision. The balance of amount shall be invested in Nationalised Bank initially for a period of three years and Fixed Deposit Receipt shall be renewed thereafter for the period until disposal of appeal.
