1. This is an application for condonation of delay of 375 days caused in filing an appeal under Section 54 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894.
2. Heard the learned Addl. Government Pleader appearing for applicants as well as Shri Natu, the learned Counsel appearing for the non-applicant.
