- 1) Leave to correct description of Respondent No.4. Instead of "Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ambejogai", it should be corrected as "Sub Divisional Officer, Parli". Corrections be made forthwith.
- 2) Heard. These petitions can be disposed of by directing Respondent Nos. 2 to 4 to take decision in the application/s tendered by the petitioner/s, claiming re-termination of compensation payable to them under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of four months from today and it is accordingly directed.
- 3) On re-determination of amount of compensation, the amount shall be paid to the petitioner/s, as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of three months from the date of such determination.
