PER COURT :

1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. In view of the fact that the amount under the award is deposited as per order of this Court, the ad interim stay granted earlier is made absolute.
3. Mr. Dande, the learned counsel opposes the application for withdrawal of the amount deposited under the award on the ground that Reference Court has granted exorbitant compensation in favour of the applicants.
4. Considering the award passed, the applicants are allowed to withdraw 25% on submitting undertaking to this court that in the event the applicants are directed to deposit the said amount, the applicants would deposit the same within one month. The applicants are further allowed to withdraw 75% amount on

furnishing solvent surety/security for the like amount. Respective civil applications are accordingly disposed of.

5. The First Appeals are **admitted**.

6. Mr. Dande, learned counsel waives notice for the respondent, acquiring body. Learned AGP waives notice for the respondents- State.
