PER COURT :-

1. The applicants pray that legal heirs of deceased respondent No.2, mentioned in paragraph No.3 of the application, be permitted to be brought on record. Delay of 746 days is sought to be condoned on the ground that the Advocate for the deceased respondent No.2 has intimated the Registry of his demise under Order XXII Rule 10A of the Code of Civil Procedure. It is, therefore, prayed that there is no delay.
2. Smt. Dubey, learned Advocate appears on behalf of the proposed respondents Nos.2/1 to 2/5. She has not opposed the application.
3. In the light of the above, this application is allowed. Delay is condoned. Order of abatement is set aside. Respondent Nos.2/1 to 2/5 be brought on record within a period of two weeks from today.
