ORAL ORDER :

This is an application for setting aside the order dated 23/02/2010 passed by the Registrar (Judicial) dismissing the matter in default for not paying printing charges.

2. There is delay of 147 days in moving the application.
3. Mr. Golewar, learned Counsel for respondent No.1, Mr. Gunale, learned Counsel for respondent No.2 and Mr. Ambhore,

learned Counsel for respondent No. 5 have not objected. As such, civil application stands granted.
