It is in the public domain that the notifications are issued by the High Court, empowering every Sessions Judge as Special Judge, for dealing with the cases under the provisions of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989. The challenge in this regard, therefore, does not survive.

3. Reading of the reasons forwarded by the learned Sessions Judge (Special Judge) would show that all the material on record has been appreciated on the basis of which reasonable and probable view is taken.
