The grievance of the petitioner made in the petition is that though the appeal filed by the petitioner challenging the externment order dated 20.4.2015, passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Parbhani is assailed before the Divisional Commissioner and as a matter of fact, after hearing the parties, the Divisional Commissioner has reserved the matter for judgment/ order, still no judgment/ order is pronounced.
