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PER COURT :

1. All these applications are filed for amendment. The Writ Petition is yet to be admitted. The learned A.G.P. for respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and the learned counsel for respondent

No. 4 have no objection if the amendment is allowed.

Looking to the fact that the Writ Petition is yet to be admitted, no prejudice will be caused to any of the respondent if the application for amendment is allowed and liberty is granted to the applicant to amend the Writ Petition, since the respondents will have opportunity to file additional reply, if any, in case reply is already filed.
