1 In view of the reply tendered on behalf of Respondent-Petroleum Corporation and more specifically in view of the fact that Respondent No.2 has been issued a letter of intent and concerned Respondent has also commenced the Gas Agency, challenge raised in the instant petition does not deserve consideration.
