PER COURT :

1. By this application, the applicant is seeking withdrawal of the amount deposited by the non-applicants.

2. Heard learned counsel for the applicant. We have also heard the learned A.G.P.

3. It is not disputed by the learned A.G.P. that writ petitions filed by the present non-applicants have been dismissed and no further proceedings are taken up against the said orders. The amount prayed for withdrawal is the amount deposited by the non-
