ORDER :

1. Pursuant to the Judgment of the Apex Court and the Report submitted by Justice Palkar Commission, it was found that the freedom fighter certificates are not proper and the pension of the Petitioners was stopped.

The same is based on the Justice Palkar Commission's Report. The authenticity of warrant etc. cannot be established by the Petitioners.
