PER COURT

1. The registration of the second appeal came to be refused, as the applicant/appellant has failed to remove the office objection.
2. There is delay of 12 days in preferring the present application.
3. The fact remains that in the second appeal, this Court has not taken cognizance. As such, in my opinion, no prejudice will be caused, if delay of 12 days is condoned.
