PER COURT :

1. Ms. S.L. Parasambal, learned Advocate holding for learned Advocate Shri V.D. Gunale submits that R.C.S. No. 51 of 2008 has been decided on 31-12-2014 by the Trial Court. As such, the petitioners would be resorting to a legal remedy as is available in law.
