4. The applicant, who has been convicted by the
learned Adhoc Additional Sessions Judge-3, Jalna vide

judgment and order dated 31/08/2015 passed in Sessions Case No. 46 of 2014, for the offences punishable under section 201 r/w. 34 of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to suffer rigorous imprisonment for 3 years for the said offences, is praying for suspension of the substantive sentences during the pendency of the appeal and his release on bail.
