. Mr.Kshirsagar, learned counsel for the Petitioners submits that the Respondent – Management has forwarded the proposal to the Education Officer (Primary) seeking approval to the appointments of the Petitioners. However, for almost two years, no decision is taken by the Respondent – Education Officer. According to the learned counsel, the Petitioners are appointed by following due procedure of law and as against the vacant posts.

2 Mr.Dharurkar, learned counsel for the Respondent – Management affirms the fact that the proposals seeking approval to the appointments of the Petitioners are already forwarded.

3 The learned counsel for the Education Officer submits that in case those proposals are pending, the same would be decided in accordance with law.

4 In light of the above, we pass the following order:

- I. The Respondent – Education Officer shall decide the proposal (Exhibit – 'F') in all the matters, in accordance with law, as per its policy, expeditiously, preferably within four months.
- II. Accordingly, all the writ petitions are disposed of. No costs.
