ORDER :

1. The petition is filed for giving directions to the investigating agency to arrest the accused mentioned in the F.I.R. given by one Akash, the relative of petitioner in C.R. No. 214/2014 registered in Shevgaon Police Station, District Ahmednagar. The crime was registered for the offence punishable under sections 395 etc. of I.P.C. Both the sides are heard.

2. The affidavit filed by the Investigating Officer and the record produced by the learned APP show that the investigation is completed and the investigating agency has come to the conclusion that no serious incident took place and

some incident of which cognizance could not be taken, NC was there. Accordingly the report is approved by the higher authority and it is submitted in the Court of J.M.F.C. for approval. In view of these circumstances, it will be open to the original complainant to contest that report before J.M.F.C. and the J.M.F.C. has ample power to do the needful. In view of this development, no directions as sought in the petition, can be given.

3. In the result, the petition stands dismissed.
