PER COURT :-

1 The grievance of the petitioners in the instant petition is that in spite of tendering applications to the respondent No.2 claiming redetermination of amount of compensation u/s 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, the applications are kept pending and no steps are initiated since last four years.

2 In the facts and circumstances of the case, this petition can be disposed of by issuing directions to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 i.e. The District Collector and the Special Land Acquisition Officer, Aurangabad to take decision on the pending applications presented by the petitioners u/s 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of six

months from today and it is accordingly directed.

3 On determination of amount of compensation, if the petitioners are held entitled to receive enhanced amount, the respondent Nos. 1 to 3 are directed to disburse the amount in favour of the petitioners as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of three months from such determination.

4 With the directions as above, writ petition stands disposed of.
