Heard Mr Kadam, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the applicant.

2. By the present application, the applicant seeks restoration of Criminal Writ Petition No.1132 of 2015, which stood dismissed pursuant to the conditional order passed by this Court on 15th September, 2015, for failure to remove office objections.

3. Mr Kadam submits that he will remove office objections, within a period of four weeks from today. The said statement is accepted as an undertaking to the Court.
