1. This application is filed for anticipatory bail. Both the sides are heard. This Court has perused the papers of investigation. The original complainant Firoz Khan S/o Khan Isaq Khan has filed affidavit which is to the effect that they have settled the dispute out of the Court and he has no objection to grant anticipatory bail to the applicant.
