Notice. Learned A.P.P. waives service of notice for the respondent-State.

2. Heard both sides.

3. The applicant, who has been convicted by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Shahada vide judgment and order dated 21st October 2015, passed in Sessions Case No. 11/2013 for the

offences punishable under Section 306 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to suffer rigorous imprisonment for two years for each of these offences and to pay fine of Rs.1,000/- for each of these offences, in default to suffer simple imprisonment for two months and one month respectively, is praying for suspension of the substantive sentences during the pendency of the appeal and his release on bail.

4. Considering the short-term sentences awarded to the applicant, the substantive sentences are hereby suspended. Upon deposit of fine amount, if not deposited till this date, the applicant be released on bail, upon his execution of P.R. bond in the sum of Rs.20,000/- (Rs. Twenty Thousand) and also upon furnishing surety in the like amount.

5. Hamdast granted.

6. Application stands disposed of.
