Per Court:

1           The Applicants are the original Petitioners in the Writ Petition. Petitioner No.15, namely, Sikandar Vajir Shaikh, has passed away. Delay of 68 days is caused on the part of the Applicants in moving this application for bringing the legal heirs of the deceased Petitioner No.15 on record.
