3. Learned A.P.P. waives notice for the
respondent-State.

4. The applicant, who has been convicted by the
learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalgaon vide judgment

and order dated 26/11/2015 passed in Special (A.C.B.) Case No. 13 of 2012, for the offences punishable under section 7, 13(1)(d) r/w. 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment for 2 years and to pay fine of Rs.25,000/-, in default to suffer simple imprisonment for 1 year for the offence punishable under section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and to suffer simple imprisonment for 2 years and to pay fine of Rs.25,000/-, in default to suffer simple imprisonment for 1 year for the offences punishable under section 13(1)(d) r/w. 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, is praying for suspension of the substantive sentences during the pendency of the appeal and his release on bail.

5. Considering the short term sentences awarded to the present applicant and the fact that those are suspended by the learned Special Judge, the substantive sentences are hereby suspended.

. Upon deposit of the fine amount, if not deposited earlier, the applicant be released on bail, upon his execution of P.R. bond in the sum of

Rs.20,000/- (Rs. Twenty Thousand) and also upon
furnishing surety in the like amount.

7. Application stands disposed of.
