Mr. G. K. Sardesai, learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant, upon instructions, seeks leave to withdraw the application, with liberty to file an application before the learned Industrial Tribunal for modification of the order.

2. Mr. Ryan Menezes, learned Counsel appearing for the respondents has no objection if the application is dismissed as withdrawn. The application is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the applicant to file an application before the learned Industrial Tribunal. In case the application is filed by the applicant, the learned Industrial Tribunal shall examine the same, on its own merits, after

hearing the parties in accordance with law.

Liberty to the respondents to file an application for withdrawal which shall be examined by the learned Tribunal on its own merits.
