2. During the course of hearing of the above petition, the main grievance of the petitioner is that despite of an inspection report dated 11 May 2015, submitted by the Health Officer, the concerned Authorities are not taking necessary action in connection with the subject-construction.

appearing for the Authorities that necessary action shall be taken in accordance with law, based on the said report submitted by the Health Officer, within a period of three months from today.
