By this application, the applicant has prayed for condonation of delay of 5 days in filing appeal against the judgment and order dated 14/08/2014 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Quepem in Criminal Case No. 36/NIA/2010/A. Vide the said judgment, the respondent has been acquitted of the offence punishable under Section 138 of the N. I. Act. No reply has been filed resisting the application, which is supported by affidavit of the applicant.
