1. Mentioned. Not on board. At the request of the learned AGP, taken on board for urgent orders.

2. The learned AGP submit that this court by order dated 15/07/2010 in Civil Application No.1458/2009 granted ad-interim relief, subject to the Applicant depositing the entire enhanced compensation as per the order passed by the Trial Court in LAR No.241/1987. He submits that they deposited the entire decretal amount in the reference court on 17/02/2015. To that effect, they made a statement in para 3 of the Civil Application. He submits that this Hon'ble Court be pleased to condone the delay in complying with the order dated 15/07/2010 and continue the stay.

3. Considering the submission made by the learned AGP and the averments made in the Civil Application, I am of the opinion that the Applicant has made out a case for allowing the Civil Application.

4. Hence, the following order:

a. Civil Application allowed in terms of prayer clause (b) which reads thus:.
