2 The Petitioner has challenged the rejection of his Application for condonation of delay in filing the Appeal, against the order passed by the Co-operative Court, Solapur. On 10 April 2002, while admitting the Petition, this Court directed the Petitioner to deposit the due amount under the award before the Appellate Court and if the amount is deposited, it is specifically ordered that the delay would be condoned and the matter would be heard on merits. It is specifically observed that if the amount due under the award is not

deposited, Rule discharged without any order as to costs.

3 Above additional order itself, in my view, is sufficient to
dispose of the present Writ Petition, as nothing survive in view of the
specific condition.

4 The Writ Petition is disposed off with liberty.

5 Rule discharged accordingly, with no order as to costs.
