. Petitioner has already availed remedy with regard to the grant of Creamy Layer Certificate. Sub-Divisional Officer, Solapur (SDO) vide order dated 11th June, 2015 has rejected the claim of the petitioner for grant of Creamy Layer Certificate. The appellate authority i.e. Collector of Solapur remanded the matter back to SDO, Solapur for taking fresh decision on the appeal filed before it.
