1. Heard Mr. Ashok Tajane, learned counsel for respondent no.1. None appears for respondent no.1.

2. This is an application for condonation of delay of 86 days in filing Second Appeal.

3. Mr. Tajane submitted that no sufficient cause is made out for condoning the delay. He invited my attention to paragraph 2 of the application.

4. Having regard to the fact that the delay is of 86 days, in the interest of justice the Application deserves to be
