2. It is submitted that petitioner's husband was working as peon in respondent No.4- school. He expired on 23rd November 2012. The petitioner filed application dated 19th December 2012 for appointment on compassionate ground. The said application has not been decided so far. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide communication dated 4th March 2013, Education Officer (Secondary), Zilla Parishad, Solapur intimated respondent No.4 to appoint the petitioner on compassionate ground.
