Heard. Grievance of the Applicant, who has sent this letter through jail seems to be that in spite of the charge being framed on 3-4-2014 and recording of evidence having commenced on 21-6-2014 only four witnesses have been examined at trial and the trial proceedings are dormant from 27-7-2014.
