2. By this petition, the petitioner is seeking direction to the respondent no.5 to initiate appropriate action against the respondent no.2. The petitioner is accused in FIR No. I-225 of 2014 registered with Hill Line Police Station, Ulhasnagar. Learned APP makes a statement that investigation into the said FIR is completed and

chargesheet is also filed before the appropriate court, and the petitioners are shown as absconding accused.
