1. Heard. This Application is preferred by the Insurance Co. for condonation of 84 days delay in filing the First Appeal challenging the judgment and award dated 24/07/2013 passed by the Commissioner for Workmen's Compensation and Judge, Labour Court, Nasik in Application (WCA) No.F-54/2008 holding that the Respondent-Claimant is entitled to Rs.3,38,880/- with 12% p.a. interest by way of compensation along with 50% penalty from original Respondent No.1.

2. The Respondent No.1 claimant vehemently opposed the Civil Application. He submits that the Applicant has not shown sufficient cause for

condonation of delay. Hence, Civil Application be dismissed.

3. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Applicant and the reasons disclosed in the Application, I am satisfied that the Applicant has made out a case for allowing the present Civil Application.

4. Hence, the following order:

i) Civil Application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a) which reads thus:

(a) The delay of 84 days in filing the appeal may kindly be condoned.

ii) Civil Application stands disposed off accordingly.
