3 The learned Counsel for the applicant submits that they already made application to the Competent Authority on 27.01.2015. But, thereafter, they received letter dated 02.02.2015 from Assistant Director, Employees State Insurance Corporation directing applicant to take permission from the

Court. Hence, he has preferred this Civil Application.
