By order dated 8 December 2015 in Civil Application No. 1052 of 2015, the Writ Petition which was dismissed for default is restored.

2. Civil Application No. 721 of 2015 is taken out by the Respondent in the original petition for withdrawal of the amount deposited. The learned Counsel for the parties informed that the amount was initially invested in fixed deposit which has reached

its maturity period on 7 December 2015 and it is yet to be reinvested. Considering the arguments advanced and that the learned Counsel for the Original Petitioner has no objection if amount is withdrawn subject to furnishing appropriate security, the Civil Application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a). The Applicant/Original Respondent is permitted to withdraw the amount deposited alongwith accrued interest on such security to the satisfaction of the Registry.

3. Civil Application is accordingly disposed off.
