This application is filed for restoration of the above writ petition by condoning short delay of 32 days.

2. Since the Office raised some objections, the said petition was placed before learned Registrar (Judl-I) on 10th October, 2013. On 10th October, 2013, learned Registrar (Judl-I) passed the following order:
